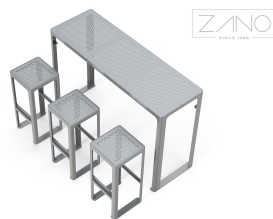
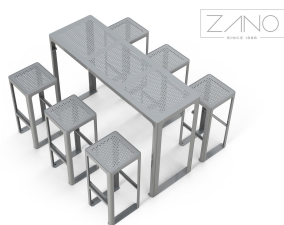

## DESCRIPTION

The high bar table for use with hockers is a modern and functional piece of small architecture, ideal for use in bars, restaurants, cafés or even in domestic hospitality spaces. The Scandik 13.046.P table is made entirely of steel. You can choose to have the product entirely in stainless steel or in carbon steel, galvanised and powder-coated in the RAL colour of your choice.

The table top is made of perforated steel. Perforated steel not only adds to the aesthetic appeal, but also improves the functionality of the table. The perforations can allow airflow, which is beneficial in hot conditions, and can also help drain water in the event of rain, which is particularly useful for tables used outdoors. In addition, the finish of the table top is smooth, making it easy to clean and maintain.
